<sup>\*</sup> April 11, 1968 - The Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Fair Housing Act): This Act was signed into law, prohibiting discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of housing based on race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. It aimed to eliminate racial barriers in the housing market, promoting equal opportunities and integration in neighborhoods across the United States.
