
Honoring the Faces of the 1963 March on Washington

- 1. Young civil rights leader who spoke at the March and later became a U.S. Congressman.
- 2. Leader of the NAACP who spoke at the March, highlighting the struggle for equality.
- 3. Civil rights leader assassinated in 1963, whose death galvanized support for the March.
- 8. Labor leader and organizer of the March on Washington.
- 9. Leader of the National Urban League, a key speaker at the March focusing on employment equality.
- 10. Baseball legend who spoke at the March, emphasizing the importance of equality in sports.
- 11. Civil rights activist and mentor to the Little Rock Nine, who spoke at the March.

DOWN

- 1. Oscar-winning actress who publicly supported civil rights and attended the March to show solidarity.
- 4. Renowned singer who performed at the March, known for breaking racial barriers in music.
- 5. Gospel singer who performed at the March, inspiring Martin Luther King Jr.'s speech.
- 6. Chief organizer of the March on Washington, known for his behind-the-scenes work.
- 7. Influential writer and activist whose works captured the essence of racial issues during the era.
