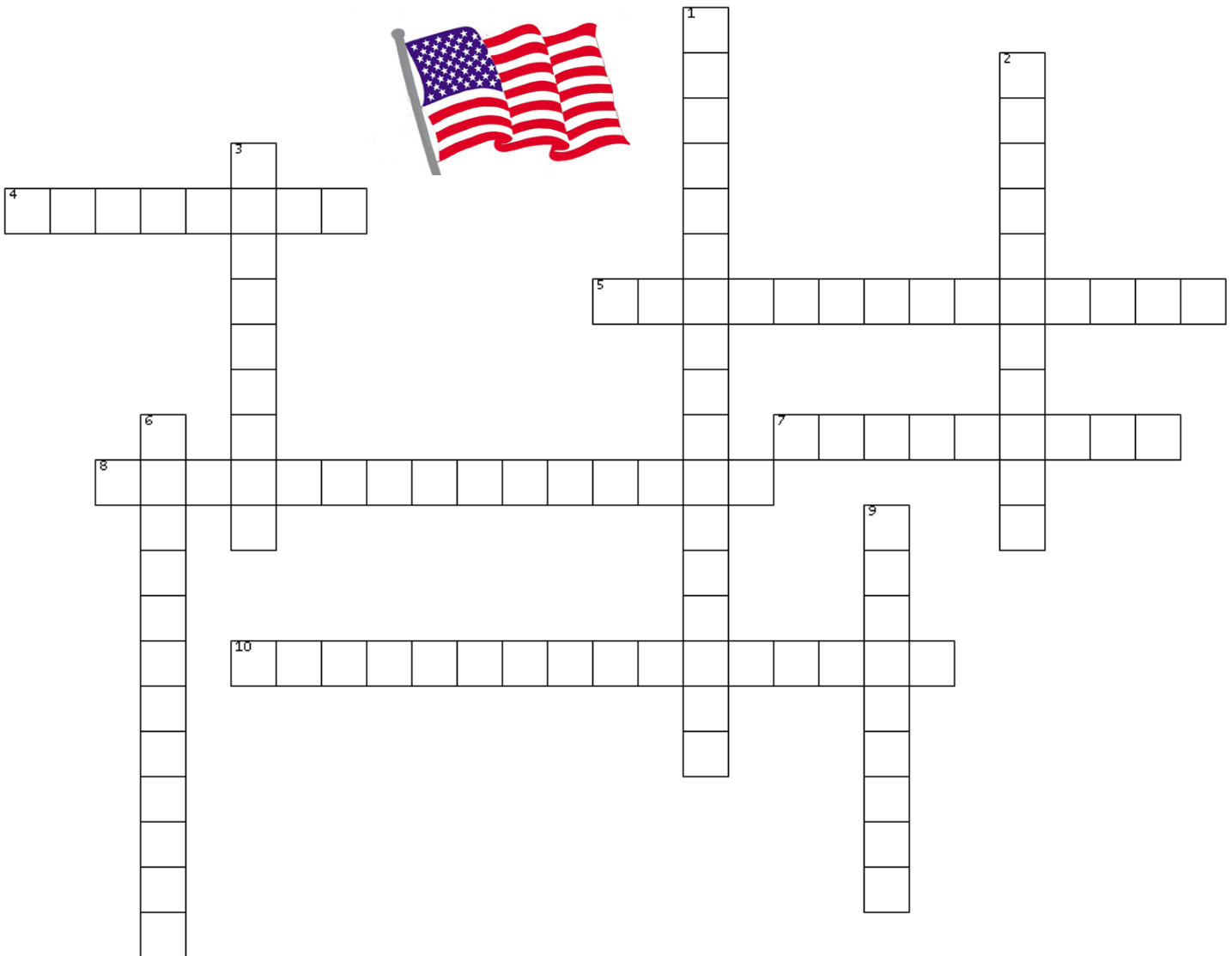


Celebrating Independence Day
